## Situation

The business situated in North Rine-Westphalia is among the ten largest slaughterhouses in Germany. It is recognized as a highly professional business with great processing know-how by suppliers from the agricultural sector as well as the customers, among them large retail chain stores and discounters. Due to an unsuccessful succession planning the company got into financial problems in 2006 and had to file for insolvency.
